

Florida All-State Team Selection Criteria

The following are the criteria used for selection of the Florida All-State Team based on the previous criteria and the revisions accepted by the Board of Directors at the Annual meeting in Jacksonville, April 16, 1999.

1. *Minimum Targets required for consideration
 - 12 Gauge – 800 (Junior & Sub-Junior 500)
 - 20 Gauge – 600 (Junior & Sub-Junior 400)
 - 28 Gauge – 600 (Junior & Sub-Junior 400)
 - 410 Bore – 600 (Junior & Sub-Junior 400)

*Only targets shot in [≡]registered bonafide competition will be included in Minimum Targets. Targets shot during [^]Monthly Target[^] registered shoots will not be included.

[≡]A Registered bonafide competition will meet all the following criteria:

- a. The shoot will be for a specific scheduled date
- b. The shoot must be “open” to members of FSA
- c. One (1) Closed Club “Members Only” Shoot per club will be allowed per skeet year
- d. The shoot must be advertised, i.e. Skeet Review, mailer, etc.
- e. The shoot must have prior approval of the Executive Board of the Florida Skeet Association and all Clubs within that Zone
- f. A Financial Report must be filed with NSSA and FSA

[^] Monthly Targets will meet the following criteria:

- a. A shoot for any/all date(s) within a time period
(I.e. Jan 1 – Jan 31)
- b. A Cumulative Financial Report will be filed with NSSA and FSA that will include all the targets shot for that time period

2. All members will have participated in at least one of the following major shoots during the selection year:

Florida State Championships
JB Maszk Hall of Fame Shoot (Formerly Florida Fall Championships)

3. Selection will be based on 4 Gun High Overall Average. Only targets shot in [≡]registered bonafide competition will be used to compute this average.

4. The selection of the teams will be as follows:
Open, Ladies, Sub-Junior, Junior, Triple Sub, Sub Sub Senior, Sub Senior, Senior, Veteran, Senior Veteran, Military, Retired Military

Each member may be selected for one team only.
